⁶ Extended visit - non-protocol visit; consists of a simple visit plus additional data collection procedures (as specified in living biobank protocol). Includes \$200 per visit for subject travel.

⁷ Specimen Collection - includes tubes, vials, needles, alcohol swabs, etc.

⁸ Specimen Shipment - includes shipping supplies, courier charges (collecting site to destination lab), dry ice (if applicable); assumes on-demand shipment at time of collection. Bulk shipment charges will vary.

⁹ Temperature stabilization refers to packaging of ambient specimens in Styrofoam cooler with temperature-stabilizing gel packs. Stabilization recommended for whole blood collected in Sodium Heparin tubes. Temperature monitors *not* provided.

¹⁰ Specimen Processing – includes processing by TN laboratory and shipment to testing laboratory; processing charge is *in addition to* specified collection charge.
